

The care- and washing instructions of linen textile

As a material, the linen is ideal as it resists dirt. It doesn't need to be washed so often, and there is no need to use strong detergents.

Washing of the linen

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When washing linen clothes or textiles, lint is being removed from the fabric. That is why you should always wash linen textiles separated from other laundry.

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Remove smudges prior to the washing with bile soap or marseille soap.

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Turn the linen clothes inside out before washing.

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Choose liquid detergent.

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If the cloth is not very dirty, it can usually be cleaned in 40° C, but linen towels or sheets should be washed in 60° C.

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Choose a gentle washing program (for example delicates or wool) Fill the laundry machine only halfway full to prevent the problematic wrinkling of the linen products.

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It is not good to use long spinning for linen products, soft spinning should be sufficient.

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Straighten the product after the washing and hang it to dry.

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It is not recommended to use softeners or tumble drying.

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Iron the cloth from the seamy side while it is still damp, this will straighten the wrinkles.

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If the linen cloth has shrunk in the washing process, try to straighten, stretch and iron it while it is damp. That should help.

Storaging the linen

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Linen clothing should be stored on a right sized hanger.

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Linen cloths (like table cloths) should be stored rolled up to prevent folds from appearing.
